

MO Native Species cannot be sold or purchased without first obtaining the proper permits outlined in the MO Wildlife Code – Chapter 9 (<http://www.sos.mo.gov/adrules/csr/current/3csr/3c10-9.pdf>). Class I and Class II permits can only be obtained from the MO Department of Conservation central office in Jefferson during regular business hours (www.mdc.mo.gov).

All species listed on the next 6 pages ARE MO NATIVE SPECIES.

Each page lists all MO Herps with the common & scientific names (before and after 2008) provided by State Herpetologist Jeff Briggler. Unless someone has a Class I or Class II Breeders permit IN HAND, WITH THE SPECIFIC ANIMAL LISTED, then they cannot be sold. Remember that the BUYER MUST ALSO HAVE THEIR BREEDERS PERMIT TO PURCHASE ANY MO NATIVE ANIMAL.
